


















Meditation Session





NEWS OF THE MONTH 2023 ROUND UP – AT A GLANCE

JANUARY 7, 2023

India, for the first time, surpassed Japan in terms of auto sales in 2022 to become the third-largest auto market in the world. A total of 4.25 million new cars were sold in the country, exceeding the sales of Japan.



MAY 12, 2023

Vast, a startup backed by billionaire Jed McCaleb, along with Elon Musk's rocket firm SpaceX, aims to launch the first commercial school bus sized, cylindrical space station named Haven-1 into orbit in August 2025.



JANUARY 11, 2023

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, flagged off the world's longest river cruise 'MV Ganga Vilas', from Varanasi to Dibrugarh in Assam via video conference. It is the first cruise ship made in India.



JUNE 15, 2023

NASA astronauts have successfully cultivated a space garden in the space station, showing the possibility of growing fresh food beyond the boundaries of the Earth.



FEBRUARY 18, 2023

An IAF C-17 Globemaster aircraft, carrying second batch of cheetahs from Johannesburg, South Africa, landed at the Air Force Station, Gwalior. The batch had 12 cheetahs (five females and seven males).



JUNE 21, 2023

'Yoga for Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam' (One Earth, One Family, One Future) organised on 21st June 2023, in Gujarat, set a new Guinness World Record for the largest gathering of people for a yoga session.



FEBRUARY 23, 2023

The US President Joe Biden, nominated Indian-American Ajay Banga to lead the World Bank on 23rd February 2023. Ajay Banga is the former Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Mastercard.




JULY 14, 2023


OCTOBER 21, 2023


